ABOUT THE COMPETITION

Communicate science (Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Computer Sceince) in 3 minutes and use your communication talent in stimulating the imagination of the public, express scientific ideas to your fellow classmates and to a non-specialist audience

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- Participants in the competition must be pupils of age 9-18. The competition, depending on the number of
 participants, may be divided in two age levels. In Level A pupils of age 9-13 can apply for participation and
 in Level B pupils of age 14-18.
- The presentation can be done either in Greek language or in English language.
- The presentation must have a correct content in biology, physics, chemistry or a combination of these sciences.
- The duration of the presentation is maximum 3 minutes. The use of audio visual tools during the presentation, such as PowerPoint, projectors, videos, audio and other is strictly prohibited. Participants are allowed to use small items that they can hold in one hand. A small table (of up to 1 square meter) will be provided.
- The SCIENCE-Factor Cyprus 2025-26 competition is Phase 1 of the International SCIENCE-Factor Europe 2026 competition. The winner of the 1st prize will automatically qualify to the final phase of the International Competition and represent Cyprus, with his/her own expenses, to the SCIENCE-Factor Europe 2026 competition, which will take place during the EUROMATH/EUROSCIENCE 2026 Conference (12-16 March 2026, Paphos, Cyprus). - Participation in the Competition presupposes that all Participants have obtained written permission from their
 parents or legal guardians prior to applying for participation in the competition. The written permission will
 have to be submitted duly signed the day of the Competition at the registration desk.
- The division of the competition by age level or by category (SCIENCEFactor and MATHFactor) will be decided according to the number of entries.
