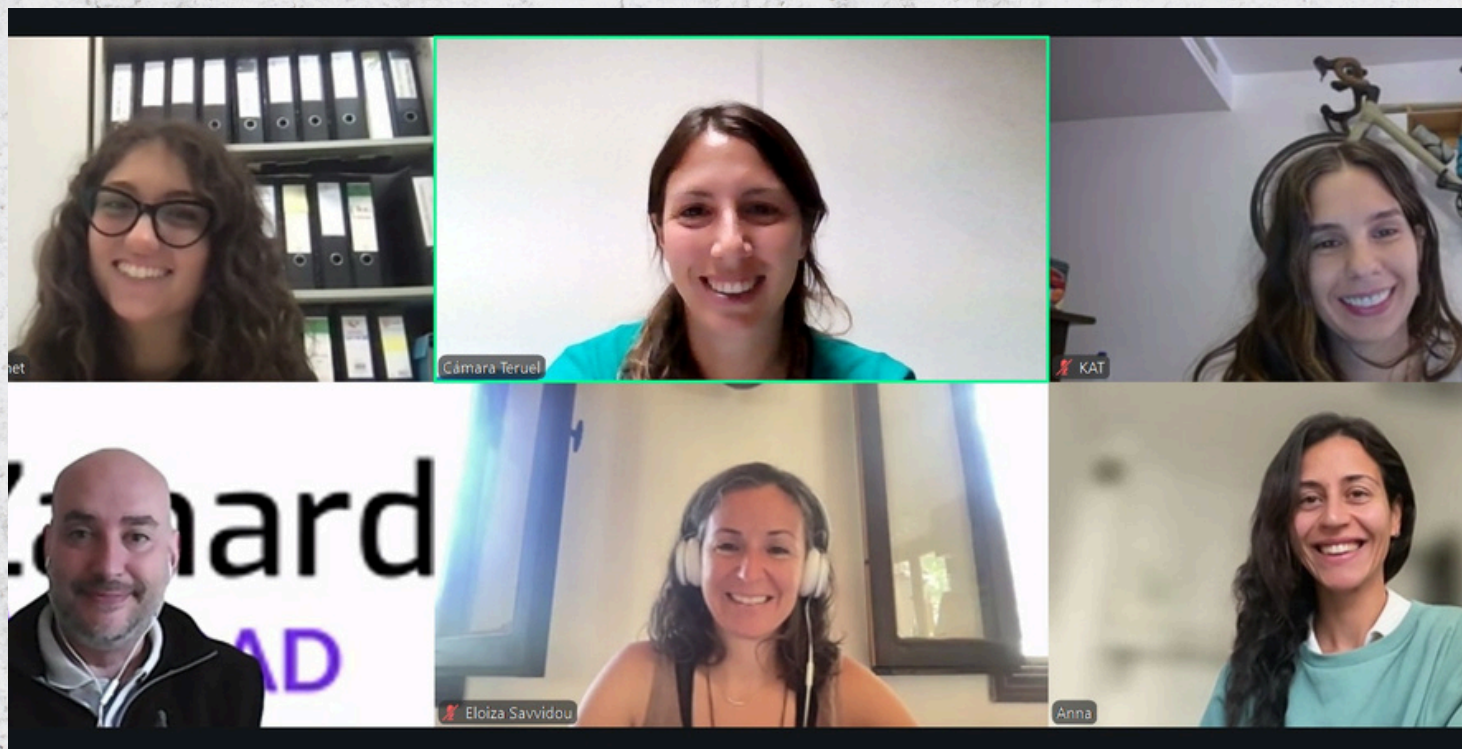

Building the foundations for the next phase

During this past semester, our teams worked intensively to complete a number of key milestones that shaped the foundation of the SFEntre project. Across five partner countries, we gathered insights, perspectives, and stories that brought the slow food entrepreneurship movement into sharper focus.

We successfully finalised two major deliverables: the **National Focus Group Reports**, which captured voices and experiences from local stakeholders in each country, and the **National Reports Summarising Policies, Trends, and Best Practices**, which provided an in-depth look into the frameworks and initiatives shaping slow food enterprises across Europe.



These findings were then brought together in publishing the 3rd deliverable, the **SFENTRE Guide** ([SFENTRE Guide](#))— a comprehensive collection of inspiring projects, organisations, and policies that have driven innovation toward more sustainable food systems and mindful consumption. The process of compiling and comparing national insights revealed both the unique approaches within each country and the shared European commitment to food that is good, clean, and fair.



What did the results show?



The results of this phase revealed a growing enthusiasm for slow food entrepreneurship—especially among young people and small-scale producers—and highlighted how supportive policies are vital to sustaining such initiatives.

With these deliverables completed, Work Package 2 came to a close, marking the end of the project's first phase. The outcomes now serve a dual purpose: providing the foundation for developing our Slow Food Entrepreneurship Training Programme, and raising broader awareness of the movement's potential to inspire communities and policymakers alike.
