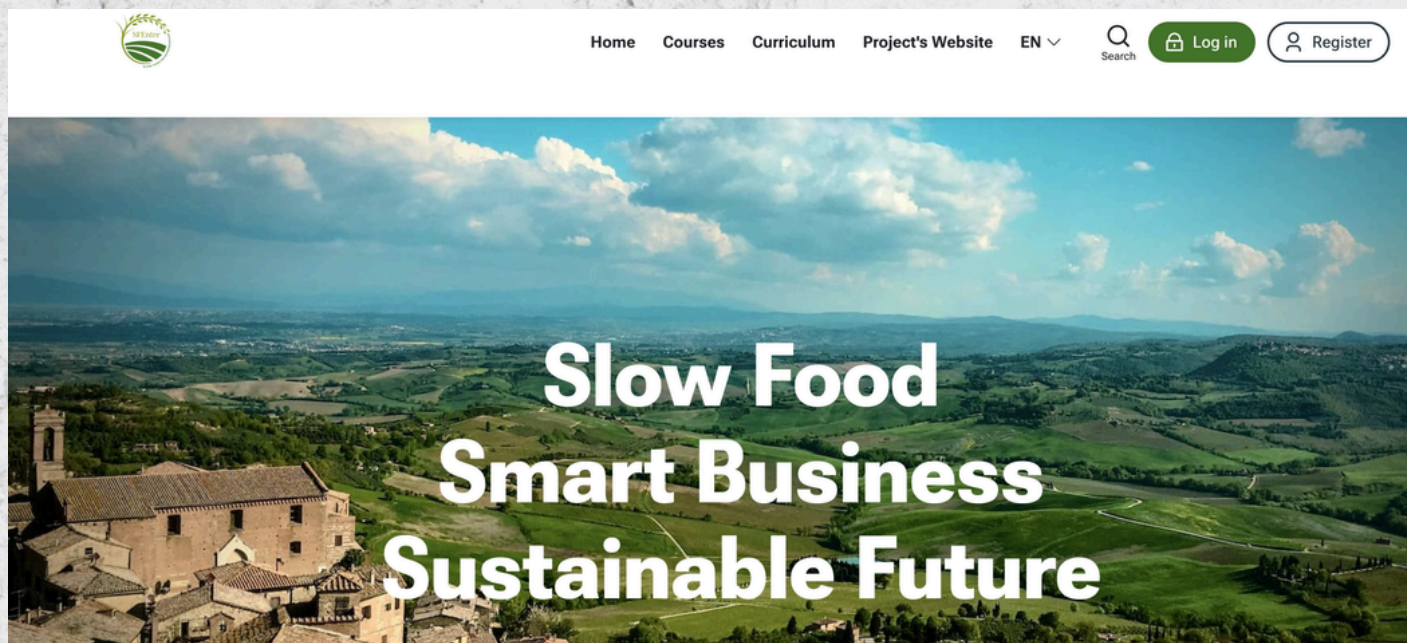


From Ideas to Action: The SFEntre Training Programme is Now Live

One of the most important achievements of the project has been the launch and piloting of the **SFEntre online learning platform**: <https://sfentre-edu.eu/>

The training programme combines sustainability, entrepreneurship and the values of the Slow Food movement, offering participants the opportunity to strengthen their skills through practical and accessible learning resources.

Across partner countries, participants are currently testing the platform, completing learning modules and obtaining micro-credentials that recognise the competences acquired throughout the training journey.



At the same time, project partners continue monitoring participation and collecting feedback to further improve the learning experience and maximise the impact of the programme.

This phase represents a crucial step in transforming the knowledge gathered during the first stages of the project into practical tools that can support future food entrepreneurs throughout Europe.



Transnational Project Meeting in Florina, Greece

From **20 to 22 May 2026**, project partners gathered in the beautiful city of **Florina**, Greece, for the latest SFEntre Transnational Project Meeting. The meeting marked an important milestone as **partners reviewed the progress achieved** so far and **coordinated the final activities** that will bring the project to a successful conclusion.



Discussions focused on:

- Progress of the SFEntre Training Programme and online platform;
- Monitoring participant engagement and course completion;
- Development of the micro-credential scheme;
- Preparation of business plan acceleration activities;
- Dissemination and exploitation of project results;
- Inclusion, diversity and quality assurance actions.



The meeting once again demonstrated the **strength of the consortium** and the shared commitment to promoting entrepreneurship that is innovative, sustainable and deeply connected to local communities.



Learning, Teaching and Training Activity – Slow Food Entrepreneurship in Practice

Alongside the Transnational Project Meeting, SFEntre partners took part in an immersive Learning, Teaching and Training Activity in Florina, Greece.

The programme combined field visits, peer learning, practical workshops and direct engagement with the local Slow Food ecosystem. Participants explored how local production, culinary heritage and sustainable entrepreneurship can be connected and transformed into viable business ideas.

Main activities

Learning from local producers. Participants visited a small garden in Polipotamo and the family-run Pantou Estate Winery, gaining first-hand insight into local production and rural entrepreneurship.

Discovering the Florina Slow Food ecosystem. Through Yenteki's storytelling and a shared lunch with local guests, participants learned about Florina's food heritage and local products.

Applying Slow Food concepts. During an interactive workshop, participants worked in groups to apply Slow Food principles to business ideas. Each group presented its conclusions and took part in a joint reflection and evaluation activity.

Peer learning and networking. The LTTA concluded with a peer-learning session where participants exchanged experiences, discussed potential applications in their respective countries and strengthened cooperation within the SFEntre partnership.





The LTTA transformed Slow Food principles into practical learning experiences, connecting local knowledge, entrepreneurship and international cooperation.

Looking Ahead: Final Meeting in Brescia

The project is now entering its concluding phase. The final Transnational Project Meeting will take place in Brescia, (Italy) and will bring together all partners to review achievements, evaluate results and discuss the sustainability of SFEntre beyond the project's official end.

The meeting will also provide an opportunity to showcase the impact generated throughout the project and celebrate the collaborative efforts that have made this European initiative possible.

As we move towards the finish line, SFEntre remains committed to supporting a future where entrepreneurship, sustainability and food culture go hand in hand.
