THE PROJECT

The SEEDS project has successfully completed its educational programme, marking a major milestone in its mission to empower teachers through Eco-Art. Moreover, last July, teachers participated in hands-on training in Spain, gaining practical experience with the SEEDS methodologies and resources.



TEACHERS TRAINING IN SPAIN

Last July, the SEEDS project organized a hands-on teachers' training in Spain, bringing together five teachers from Cyprus and five from Spain. During the training, participants were introduced to the project and guided through a variety of activities from the SEEDS educational programme, including painting tote bags with natural pigments, engaging in interactive group exercises, and creating ephemeral art. The session provided teachers with practical experience and foundational knowledge, enabling them to confidently apply the project's methodologies in their classrooms.
